

The Cards kicked off the week with a tough match against the #12 ranked Grant Generals. The first set was a battle back and forth between the Generals and Cardinals, with the Generals taking the first set 23-25. Varsity was unable to gain back the momentum the rest of the match, ending the next two sets 14-25, & 19-25. We look forward to a rematch against Grant!

On Thursday the Cards took on Franklin, taking home the match 3-1. Varsity was able to mix up the lineup and try some players in new positions. Anna Jendsen did a great job running a 6-2 setting with Nikki Nassib. Some key hitters in this match were Katharina, Koko, Lily, & Kathryn.

Saturday the Cards hosted our first Varsity Tournament. Playing great in the morning against Woodburn, Reynolds, & McMinnville got them into the gold bracket for the afternoon. In a rematch semi-finals re-match against Tigard Varsity was unable to close out the match, losing to the Tigers 1-2.

This week we have another battle of the birds match against Wells on Tuesday, followed by our first match of the season against Benson at the newly remodeled school.

We had an all-out battle on Tuesday at home vs. Grant (23-25, 24-26, 15-13). The team has been looking forward to this game all season, and even with leads in both of the first two sets, the Cards weren't able to seal the deal. We did, however, rally for the third set win to end on a high note! Ultimately, both teams were evenly matched and it was a great back and forth game with lots of great rallies. At practice on Wednesday, we talked about pressure and what that looks and feels like for each player and our team, and we feel confident that next time we take on Grant we'll be able to channel that energy into our best volleyball!

Then on Thursday, the Cards took on Franklin, dominating the match with an all-new lineup (25-13, 25-17, 15-4). Freshman Ellie Drake stepped up into the libero position (and as an outside hitter) and excelled at it. She stayed gritty in the back row on defense, and helped lead the back row when we started lowering our volume. Junior Eliza McCurdy also had a fantastic day, playing all the way around on the outside. She was hitting aggressively, serving with intensity, and was a rock in the back row for our team.

Overall this week, the cards served 92% (passing our team goal of 90%!) and almost a 20% ace rate. Very impressive!

JV2 faced challenges this week with multiple athletes sidelined by illness, resulting in unfamiliar lineups. Despite this, they continued their winning streak, securing a victory against Grant on Tuesday and easily defeating Franklin on Thursday.
